



Lorain County's Clean and Beautiful Program

Through Lorain County's Clean and Beautiful Program, individuals, neighborhood and community groups, and schools can apply for beautification projects through borrowing our Clean and Beautiful trailer and its equipment

These projects are aimed at helping county residents improve their neighborhoods' aesthetics. Well-maintained and clean communities discourage littering and illegal dumping. Clean communities also contribute to the overall health and well-being of county residents, sustainability of the environment, increased property values and attracting new businesses to the neighborhood.

This can be achieved by beautifying surrounding areas through activities such as community cleanups, and beautification projects completed by volunteer groups.

- Volunteer Organizations, Communities, church groups, youth groups, girl/boy scouts, etc. can borrow our Clean and Beautiful trailer and its equipment for FREE.
- Authorized agent must be at least 25yrs to sign out the trailer and drive away with it. A copy of valid drivers license is required.
- You must be at least 21yrs to operate the power equipment in the trailer.
- The trailer must be requested in writing prior to the date to allow time for scheduling, etc. and can be requested to use for up to 72 hours.
- Trailer must be picked up and returned to the collection center.
(A review & sign off of all equipment will be done upon pickup and return.)
- The equipment in the trailer enables groups/organizations to perform site cleanups or beautifications, plant community gardens, etc.
- We ask that the groups that borrow our trailer take and send us before & after pictures of their projects so that we can use them to help promote the program.
