



Job Posting Bascule Bridge Tender

The Lorain County Board of Commissioners are accepting applications for a Bascule Bridge Tender. Under general direction, the successful candidate will, operate console that raises and lowers bridge, monitor approaching pedestrians and vehicles, conduct safety checks when ships approach. Perform other related duties as required.

This individual must have knowledge of safety practices and procedures; Knowledge of drawbridge operating procedures; Ability to co-operate with co-workers coordinating operation of drawbridge; deal with problems involving several variables with familiar context; carry out instructions in written or oral form; communicate effectively with local authorities; Skill in operating drawbridge, radio equipment; Ability to maintain accurate records, complete routine reports, complete accurate, concise and meaningful reports; Knowledge of lubrication of machinery; Ability to demonstrate physical fitness and dexterity; Skill in use of tools.

Qualifications and License Requirements:

Any combination of training and work experience which indicates possession of the skills, knowledge and abilities listed below. An example of an acceptable qualification for this position is: completion of secondary education or equivalent, along with 12 months experience as Bridge Tender Trainee. Ability to demonstrate physical fitness. Must possess a valid Ohio vehicle operator's license and maintain continuing eligibility for coverage under the existing vehicle insurance policy held by the County.

Position Starts at \$16.00/hour; overtime. This is a full-time, union position with some weekends as needed.
