WHEREAS, the Lorain County Board of Commissioners have previously approved funding of storm water projects using ARPA; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have adopted a General Plan of Drainage;

WHEREAS, the Lorain Soil and Water Conservation District, Firelands School District and the County have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding to improve drainage at the Firelands School District campus in Henrietta Township; and

WHEREAS, Soil and Water has prepared plans to improve drainage for the campus and the Firelands School District has agreed to maintain the improvement and grant the County the ability to regularly inspect and if necessary restore the improvement at the school district's cost.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lorain County Board of Commissioners that the Board Schedule a Hearing on June 27, 2023 where the Board may take action on the amendment of the Lorain County General Plan of Drainage to include the improvement of constructing a drainageway to better the function of storm water control measures and protect land and improvements at the Firelands School District Campus in Henrietta Township, finding that it is necessary for the preservation and promotion of the public health and welfare and that there will be no assessments charged for the Construction and ongoing maintenance of the improvement in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 6117.06.
