Exact change is required. Drivers DO NOT carry cash. (Fares are based on a one-way trip)

## Fixed Route 10-Ride/Weekly Pass

Riders may be required to show identification (i.e., Medicare Card or Fare Deal Card) to show proof of eligibility in order to participate in the discounted fare program. Senior Citizens may have to show a Fare Deal Card or ID with age on it.

## LCT Travel Trips

1. For your safety, please use your seat belt. Also, please hold on to seat handles or railing while the bus is moving.
2. To make the trip more enjoyable for you and other passengers, refrain from raising your voice, eating or drinking on the bus, or playing music without using earphones; note also that you may not smoke, spit, use obscenities or litter on the bus, and that vandals will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. No gasoline and flammable liquids are allowed on the bus. No firearms or weapons of any type are allowed on the bus. We ask that you follow the directions of the driver - he or she is authorized to ask you to leave LCT buses for misbehavior.
3. All animals must be kept in appropriate containers with absorbent material on the carrier floor, except for certified aid animals accompanying persons with disabilities.

## To Catch the Bus

We recommend that you be waiting for your bus at least five minutes early so that you do not miss it. To catch the bus YOU MUST be at one of the bus stop locations. YOU MUST be standing by an LCT bus sign. Wait until the bus has come to a complete stop before walking toward it.

## Boarding the LCT Bus

Wait for passengers to exit before attempting to enter the bus. After entering, move toward the rear of the bus. Note that seats in the front of the bus are reserved for senior citizens and persons with disabilities - please be considerate and offer these seats to passengers who may need them. An adult must accompany children under twelve (12) years of age.
